



Lucia Brajkovic, Ph.D.

Executive Director of HEISEE

Lucia Brajkovic serves as the executive director of the Higher Education Initiative for Southeastern Europe (HEISEE), and senior research specialist at the American Council on Education (ACE) in Washington, DC. She completed her doctoral degree at the Institute of Higher Education (IHE), University of Georgia, USA. Her dissertation research focused on political economy and higher education systems in post-socialist countries of Central and Eastern Europe. She is also exploring the internationalization of higher

education, and the connections of elite universities with the industry and corporate world - particularly with transnational corporations.

During the course of her doctoral program she served as a Fulbright Fellow at the Institute of Higher Education, a graduate research assistant at UGA's Carl Vinson Institute of Government, summer graduate research associate and later a consultant at ACE, and a doctoral intern at HEISEE.

Brajkovic also holds a master's degree in philosophy and sociology from the University of Zagreb and a diploma in public relations management. Prior to leaving to the United States for doctoral studies she worked as a public relations and special projects officer at the University of Zagreb.

Brajkovic is a co-recipient of the 2014-15 Zell and Shirley Miller Graduate Fellowship, which is given by IHE professors to students with outstanding scholarly potential, academic record and professional achievements.
